


The Pine Ridge ATV/ORV/Cycle Route

Trail Length: 49 Miles



Newberry-Rexton Motorcycle Trail

A pure twisty single track trail, for motorcycles only. **Connections on** each end can add more miles and loops to explore. Winding through deep vegetation, it is mostly flat. The trail is marked with orange blazes. From Newberry, go south on M123 to M28. East on M28 to **County Road 403** South to the very end for the staging area.
